What to do - Students

How could you make your local public playground safer by adding something to it?

1. Draw a public playground.
2. Use a different colour to change the picture to improve it by adding something that would make it safer.

Conducting the activity: This activity is designed as an individual task and works with student's creativity.

Class discussion: Can we make things better by adding to them? Ask students if they have any examples of something that they think has been improved by adding something to the original. It does not have to be a safety example.

Students should draw a picture of a public playground as it is now. Then using a different colour they should add a change to the original that would make the playground safer.

Expanding the activity: This activity could be expanded by getting the class as a whole to select one improvement that could be used as a safety product or solution to be nominated for a WorkSafe Award (it is not intended that it actually be submitted).
