What to do - Students

1. Work with the whole class to make a list all of the people who work or go to your school (include students).
2. Write down what you think the role is of each of the people in the school.
3. Write down what they should do to make sure your school is safe.

Conducting the activity: This activity is designed as a whole class activity.

Class discussion: Discuss the concepts of roles and responsibilities.

As a whole class, get students to develop a table listing the people who work in the school - for example, principal, teacher, gardener, librarian, school nurse, canteen worker. Include the role and responsibility each person has.

Expanding the activity: The activity could be expanded to look at the concept of responsibility in terms of belonging to a community or to society.
